

Mural HowTo

Structure

The mural is organized in several sections:

- Section 0 is to centralize all material for **workshop preparation**
 - Section 0.0 contains all logistical information about the workshop
 - Section 0.1 is for self-introduction of participants
 - Section 0.2 contains preliminary reading
 - Section 0.3 is for preliminary reflection of participants
- Sections 1-5 are to compile all ideas and insights **throughout the workshop**
 - Section 1 contains information and feedback opportunities about the invited talks
 - Section 2 is for announcing and discussing posters by the participants
 - Sections 3-5 are communication platforms for various steps of the workshop
- Additionally there are the sections
 - "Help desk" to ask and answer practical questions about the workshop. We will check the help desk regularly and reply to all questions. You can of course also write an E-Mail to one of the workshop organizers.
 - "Stationary", which provides a collection of copy&paste items to populate the mural with your comments and contributions

- All documents linked to from the mural are collected in a Google drive. You can access the Google drive through the "Open" button in section "0.0 → Access all Resources".

Color coding

The different colors used in the mural reflect the topical components of the workshop: **Light blue** is for Information Theory, **mid blue** for Modeling Sciences, **dark blue** for Domain Sciences. **Violet** is for bridge topics.

Usage

Feel free to engage with the mural at any stage. As a visitor (anyone with the link to the mural) you will have read-only rights, as a guest (all workshop participants will be guests) you will have read&edit rights. Throughout the workshop, we will leverage the documentation of activities and discussion via the Mural to synthesize workshop outcomes and identify next avenues together.

- Add notes in the form of post-its to any part of the mural. When doing so, please always add your name to the post-it
- You can also visually comment on existing entries with the icons provided in the "Stationary" section
- Please do not delete items
- If you have questions about the mural, please leave a note in the "Help Desk" section. We will check it regularly. Of course you can also approach any of the organizers via E-Mail.
- The entire mural or subsections can be download in different formats like pdf. This provides a comprehensive summary at every stage to all participants.
